## 14<sup>th</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time – 9<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup> July 2017

*"Come to me, all you who labour and are overburdened, and I will give you rest" (Mt. 10:37-42)*

Today there is a special invitation from Jesus to take a rest and find peace in him. Jesus knew very well that life is not easy. He personally experienced it while in Nazareth with his parents, relations and the people whom he works with. He was fully aware of the struggles and frustrations that people had to endure. And He didn't want people to keep doing it without rest. Jesus felt deeply for people and wanted to lighten them. People from different walks of life and from far distant places came to him with their worries, anxieties and problems and Jesus helped them. In fact his mere presence already brings peace to a weary and troubled soul. And it is the love of Jesus that makes heavy loads light.

As Jesus gives us rest, lighten our loads and brings us peace, it is now upon us to return the favor of letting others experience the same as Pope Francis said: "Once you have received the refreshment and comfort of Christ, we are called in turn to become refreshment and comfort for our brothers and sisters, with a meek and humble attitude, in imitation of the Master". Pope Francis then wants the church to be a place of rest for the weary, a place where we share and help each other.

Fr Rick will be away on holiday at the beginning of next week and will return for our weekend Masses. He will then take two weeks holiday from 17-31 July. The parish office will be closed next week as Melanie is away on leave. The office will re-open on Tuesday, 18 July. Due to Melanie being away this bulletin covers both the 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> Sunday in ordinary time.
