Recently some of you may have been receiving emails purporting to be from priests of the diocese asking for assistance or a favour. Please do not reply to these emails

These emails are not genuine and are phishing attempts. You can check whether the email is genuine or not by paying attention to the address. For example the phishing email might come from frjbrown@gmail.com but Fr Brown's real email address is frbrown@gmail.com There is only a slight difference in address, but close enough to trick some people. This is a pretty common scam and the church is an easy target.

As far as we can ascertain the email accounts of the affected priests have not been hacked. Instead the scammers are using publicly available records to carry out the phishing attempts.
