There will be no 9.00am Mass at Bryndwr on a Saturday morning. Between the two parishes on a Saturday morning, there will be one 9.00am Mass at Burnside. Confessions will be held at both parishes on Saturday from 9.30am - 10.30am. This change will take effect on 9 February 2019
