Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time - 30 July 2017

"The kingdom of heaven is like a treasure hidden in a field...like a merchant looking for fine pearls; when he finds one of great value...sells everything he owns and buys it"

(Mt. 13:44-45)

Jesus once again teaches the crowd about the kingdom of heaven by way of three short parables. Three aspects of God's kingdom are highlighted in these parables namely recognizing the kingdom's ultimate value, responding with total commitment and possibly rejecting the gift of eternal life. The parables tell us that the kingdom is worthwhile, appealing and precious and the person who finds it must sacrifice everything to obtain it. God passionately desires to be with us. What is lacking is our passion and desire to be with God. It is an all out call for openness and choice to be with HIM, so a yes is a great and an excellent response to God's invite.

Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary - 15 August

Mary's assumption into heaven is the Patronal Feast of the Catholics in Aotearoa New Zealand and was declared by the New Zealand Catholic Bishops Conference as a Holy Day of Obligation. The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches that there are two precepts of the holy day of obligation: i.] the obligation "to participate in the mass...unless excused for a serious reason" (CCC#2180) and ii.] the obligation to "refrain from engaging in work or activities that hinder the worship owed to God, the joy proper to the Lord's day, the performance of the works of mercy and the appropriate relaxation of mind and body...unless excused by family needs, employment or important social service" (CCC#2185). To help us fulfill our obligation, here at CTK we are having Four Masses: 7am, 9am and 11am (School Mass) and 7pm. To express our love and devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary, everyone is also invited to the Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and the recitation of the Holy Rosary immediately after our 7pm Mass until 9pm.

Young New Zealanders are being called to share their views about life, faith, and their experience of Church through an online survey published today by the New Zealand Catholic Bishops. The Catholic Church is launching a nation-wide survey for all youth. The survey is part of an international effort by Pope Francis to better understand the lives, attitudes and concerns of young people around the world, in the lead up to the Synod on "Young people, faith and vocational discernment" in Rome, October 2018.

The closing date for responses is midnight on Sunday, 27 August 2017.
