"The wedding is ready...go to the crossroads in the town and invite everyone you can find to the wedding...the wedding hall was filled with guests." (Mt. 22:1-10)

The parable of the Wedding Feast presents a King who invites guests to his Son's wedding. Those who were invited declined for many different reasons. What a surprise, a King's invite had been refused by the chosen people? But no one can stop him to ask people to be at the wedding. So even if he was refused already he still perseveres, he said to the servants invite whomever you find in the crossroads. However, accepting the king's invitation requires certain obligations, that is, the guest should wear an appropriate wedding dress. It reminds us that to be invited to heaven needs to meet its requirements, free from sin and be in God's grace. To accept the invitation is also to accept its obligations. It is not so much about the exclusive beliefs as a chosen people but more of who is ready and prepared. If today you hear God's invite, harden not our hearts. In humility accept it and be ready.
