"After sending the crowds away he went up into the hills by himself to pray."

(Mt. 14: 22-33)

It is said that the more a person is attuned to God in prayer the more that person exerts power over nature. Jesus was able and can do everything because he always found time to be with God in prayer. When rapt in prayer and contemplation, St Dominic Sabio and St. Vincent Ferrer also exerted power over nature by way of levitation and bi-location. Why did Peter sink in the lake? He was not attuned to God. He lost focus on Jesus. He let fear overpower him. To be able to do everything even that which is impossible, one should maintain that faith relationship with God. Leonardo Da Vinci also once said that true power and authority shows itself in silence. The divine power of Jesus was manifested in great silence when asked before Pilate. People who hold true authority and command respect know the secret of silence like St. Paul of Tarsus, St. John of the Cross, St. Teresa of Calcutta and St. Pope John Paul II. They were all acquainted with Prayer and Silence. The gospel this Sunday reminds us of the beauty and power of Prayer and Silence. Let us make it part of our daily life?

Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary - 15 August

Mary's assumption into heaven is the Patronal Feast of the Catholics in Aotearoa New Zealand and was declared by the New Zealand Catholic Bishops Conference as a Holy Day of obligation. The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches that there are two precepts of the holy day of obligation: i.] the obligation "to participate in the mass...unless excused for a serious reason" (CCC#2180) and ii.] the obligation to "refrain from engaging in work or activities that hinder the worship owed to God, the joy proper to the Lord's day, the performance of the works of mercy and the appropriate relaxation of mind and body...unless excused by family needs, employment or important social service" (CCC#2185). To help us fulfill our obligation, here at CTK we are having Four Masses: 7am, 9am and 11am School mass and 7pm. To express our love and devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary, everyone is also invited to the Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and the recitation of the Holy Rosary immediately after mass until 9pm.
