#### What are Primary School Attendance Dues?

Attendance Dues are a legal charge set by the Bishop for families attending Catholic Primary Schools. They are not a donation. Attendance Dues are for property related costs, including compliance costs, school building works, loan repayments, building insurance and costs directly associated with the administration of attendance dues. When parents sign preference certificates they are agreeing to pay the attendance dues, in full, on/or before the due date.

Please note that no contributions are made by the Government for Attendance Dues matters or Catholic Special Character Contribution services.

As stated Attendance Dues are compulsory. Currently the Parish is owed \$17,000 in outstanding Attendance Dues. The Parish receives an invoice quarterly from the Diocese and this must be paid. The Parish cannot continue to carry this outstanding debt.

Father Rick asks that all families with outstanding Attendance Dues please make payment promptly or contact the Parish Office to arrange a payment plan - 03 358 2611 ctk.parish@xtra.co.nz If you are experiencing hardship (loss of income/redundancy, family reasons, etc.) and need some financial support you are encouraged to approach your parish priest to discuss your circumstances.

Bishop Paul has confirmed the new rate for 2020 for Primary School Attendance Dues in the Christchurch Diocese and are as follows:-

#### Attendance Dues Catholic Special Character Contribution \$50.00 per annum (\$12.50 per term)

**\$330.00** (incl GST) *per annum* (82.50 per term)

For any families with an Automatic Payment in place, please note that this will need to be increased by January 2020 to cover this increase.

We appreciate those families who regularly pay their accounts in full and on time. We also thank parishioners who have helped families in need to pay these Attendance Dues.
