## Pentecost Sunday - 9 June 2019

"Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love."

This weekend we celebrate the great feast of Pentecost. In the upper room, the Apostles gathered, and the Holy Spirit came upon them. If we recall, the upper room was where the disciples hid for fear of the Jews after Jesus had **died**. But now, this upper room is no longer a place of **timidity** and **anxiety**. It is here that the Apostles are transformed from timid and fearful people to **courageous**, **gutsy** and **Spirit-filled disciples** who were able to spread the Good News of Christ in different languages.

This weekend, Bishop Paul reveals to the whole Diocese his proposal. The same Spirit that led the apostles in spreading the Gospel of Jesus now moves within our Diocese as we look towards the future.

We ask that you pray with, and reflect on, the Bishop's proposal while asking the Spirit to guide our thoughts, minds and hearts. May we continue to be open to the movements of the Spirit, which often gives us the power to spread the Gospel of Jesus in a **new**, **brave** and **gutsy** way.
